Who we are and what we do



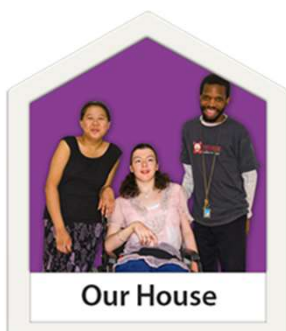
We are a small team of researchers.
